These are minor triads in five forms based on Cm, open Am, Gm, open Em and open Dm chords.

Cm and Am forms have the root on the 5th string, and Gm and Em forms have the root on the 6th string. Dm form and small Fm form, which can be found in Em form, have the root on the 4th string.

Cm and Gm forms are very difficult to play as a chord so play minor triad inversions that can be found within the forms, and also play melodically.

Note that 5 on the 6th string in Cm and Am form and on the 5th string in Dm form are optional, and the squared notes are alternatives.
