## CAGED 7th Chords

These are major 7th chord arpeggios in the five forms of CAGED. In order to play different types of 7th chords from the forms below, refer to the followings.

Minor 7th (b7) is a half step below major 7th (7), and diminished 7th (bb7) & major 6th (6) are a whole step below major 7th. Minor 3rd (b3) is a half step below major 3rd (3), and suspended 4th (4) is a half step above major 3rd. Diminished 5th (b5) is a half step below perfect 5th (5), and augmented 5th (#5) is a half step above perfect 5th.

Major 7th (Maj7,  $\triangle$ 7, Ma7): Major Triad + 7 Dominant 7th (7): Major Triad + b7

Minor 7th (min7, m7,-7):

Minor Triad + b7


